**HOUSING INFORMATION**

Hartford Seminary has reserved a block of rooms at Saint Joseph's College in West Hartford for the duration of the USS Polity Course and Synod. Saint Joseph's has a beautiful campus, dining services, very clean modern facilities, and a warm and friendly staff. Saint Joseph's Campus is located approximately 10 minutes from the Seminary by car, and also has convenient access to public transportation to travel to both the Seminary and Downtown Hartford. There is limited disabled access at Saint Joseph's, so please make note on your housing application if this accommodation will be required.

The cost per room is \$39 per night, which includes continental breakfast daily between 7:30am and 9:00am. There is a one-time \$15 fee for linens. You will also have access to a kitchenette, so feel free to bring any additional items you may need. The rooms have an overhead light, but I have been told that if you do a lot of reading at night, you may want a reading lamp. If you run hot, you may also want to bring along a small fan. It is always difficult to predict what the weather will be like in June.
