

**Hartford Seminary  
Cooperative Master of Divinity Program  
with Drew Theological School  
Advising Guidelines**

Important note: This chart is intended to help students in the Cooperative M.Div. program make informed choices about courses they may take at Hartford Seminary that will satisfy core area degree requirements at Drew Theological School. Students should be aware, however, that whether or not a Hartford Seminary course will meet a specific area requirement is a determination that is finally in the hands of the Drew faculty, and that decision is made after the student has applied and been admitted to Drew. This chart is a reliable guide of equivalency. Because course offerings and degree/curricular requirements at all institutions change over time, students should ask their advisors each academic year for the most recent version of this document.

Pastoral Formation 1 and 2 (3 credits)	WS 610, 613, 619, or AM 520
Biblical Literature 1 and 2 (6 credits)	SC 519 or 522, and 531
Church History 1 and 2 (6 credits)	HI 520 and 585
Systematic Theology and an advanced theology course (6 credits)	TH 505 or 605; any upper level TH course
Religion and the Social Process (3 credits)	RS 536
Christian Ethics (3 credits)	ET 525 or ET 630
Introduction to Educational Ministries (3 credits)	Must be taken at DUTS
Introduction to Pastoral Care (3 credits)	AM 602 or AM 638
Church @ Worship (Worship and Preaching; 6 credits)	Two of WS 632, AM 575, AM 627
Supervised Ministry 1 and 2 (6 credits)	Must be taken at DUTS
A world religions course	Any 3 credits in DI
A cross-cultural course	Must be taken at DUTS
Electives	All courses eligible

Notes: up to 42 credits are eligible to transfer to DUTS. Credits that are not applied to required courses can be applied to electives.
