

J-1 RESEARCH SCHOLAR Applicant Fees & Related Information 2017-2018

Individual Research Scholars:

Fall Semester: September, October, November, December (Sept. 5-Dec. 21)

Spring Semester: February, March, April, May (Jan. 16-May 3)

Hartford Seminary Fee: \$5,070 per semester. Includes the following:

Rent on campus (includes: heat, electricity, hot water, basic internet access, and basic cable TV connection in the living room, and a monthly cleaning fee)

- Security Deposit-\$1,200 (includes \$100 deposit applied to first month's rent, \$500 remainder of first month's rent, and \$600 security deposit).
- One-time fee for use of linens-\$10

Full access to Hartford Seminary's Library.

An assigned Seminary faculty member as your liaison.

Consultation with all seminary faculty where appropriate in connection with your exchange program.

Opportunities to teach, lecture, observe or consult in relation to your research topic.

Attendance at all seminary events.

Participation in interfaith discussions, formally and informally with our diverse student body.

*Research Scholars who live on campus during the summer months (June, July, and August) are required to pay rent (\$620 per month) which includes the monthly supplemental cleaning fee.

Research Scholars with Dependents: (must secure off-campus housing)

Fall Semester: September, October, November, December (Sept. 5-Dec. 21)

Spring Semester: February, March, April, May (Jan. 16-May 3)

Hartford Seminary Fee: \$2,000 per semester (see above for what is included in fee excluding on-campus rent)

Off campus housing costs: (estimates)

Rent: \$960-\$1300 per month

Internet connection: \$30 per month

Heat: \$150-\$300 per month

Electricity: \$50-\$150 per month

Living expense costs for on and off campus per individual (estimates)

Food: \$300 per month

Personal expenses: \$50 per month

Transportation around Hartford, Connecticut: \$45 per month

Cellular Phone: \$25 per month



Additional costs for all Research Scholars excluding Hartford Seminary Fee:

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) fee: \$160-\$250 – *if applicable*

Or

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) fee: \$215 – *if applicable*

DS-160 Nonimmigrant visa application fee: \$160

One-time SEVIS I-901 Fee: \$180 – required for Form DS-2019 (paid by the J-1 Visa holder only, not J-2 dependents)

Please Note: J-2 dependents have to pay the visa application fee only

Medical insurance: \$74-\$160 per month per person (estimate)

All fees charged to you by Hartford Seminary must be paid by the due date given. Fees are due by the first day of the semester. If any fees are not paid and you have not made a payment arrangement with Ms. Wood, your DS-2019 record may be in jeopardy of being terminated under the exchange program guidelines set forth by Hartford Seminary.

Cancellation Policy: No refunds will be given to Research Scholars who withdraw from the J-1 Exchange Visitor Program before the end date as noted on their Form DS-2019 or if their end date is prior to the end of the fall or spring semesters (dates as noted above).
